HOW TO GET READY STAY INFORMED EVACUATE RETURN

Purpose

Last year, brochures were provided by the HOA Safety Committee to all homeowners with information on preparing your home for wildfire and information on evacuation.

The Tuscany HOA Safety Committee has compiled in this brief document what we feel is critical information. It includes emergency contacts and instructions which can be used in preparation for and during emergency situations. This document is designed for quick reference that can be saved on your phone or other electronic devices. The more prepared we are as a community the better we'll be able to respond in an emergency.

Each of the sections herein have Links that provide detailed information enabling you to develop a personal Emergency Action Plan for your family and home.

Preparation- Do This Now

Register your phone with the Contra Costa County Sherriff's Office of Emergency Service Community Warning System (CWS). The CWS only calls cell phones that are registered. This system notifies subscribers to life threatening emergencies. Registration link: https://cwsalerts.com/registration/

Subscribe to the Danville Police NIXLE site. This system is used to transmit non-life-threatening messages to area residents. NIXLE might be the first method used to notify residents of a small fire.

Sign up for alerts from PG&E regarding the planned Public Safety Power Shutoffs. www.pge.com/emergencypreparedness

Sign up for Pulse Point Respond. This is a 911-connected app that can immediately inform you of emergencies occurring in your community and can request your help when CPR is needed nearby. https://www.pulsepoint.org/

Sign up with the Town of Danville Notify Me for emergency alerts.

Evacuation

Red Flag Warning. This will be announced by the National Weather Service and news media. Make sure that you have at least ¾ full tank of fuel, park your vehicle in the driveway facing the street. If you feel you are in danger, consider evacuating early, before the Mandatory Evacuation Order is given.

Pre-evacuation preparation (when an evacuation is anticipated).

Evacuation. When a manditory evacuation order is announced, leave immediately.

Take only a single vehicle to help reduce traffic jams.

Evacuation contacts- Use TEXT messages with no photos and no voice phone calls, send a text message to your Out-of-State-Contact (OoSC) when evacuating, indicating your destination, send another text message to your OoSC when you arrive at your destination.
